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Breaking Ground Tomorrow:

New Rail Project at International Trade & Transportation Center (ITTC) in Shafter

WHAT: The City of Shafter and The Allen Group announce groundbreaking tomorrow on a rail

project that will service the International Trade and Transportation Center (ITTC), the 700-

acre industrial park located in Shafter in the southern San Joaquin Valley.

The rail service will be provided by the BNSF Railway and be owned by the City of Shafter. The ITTC is located between Highway 99 and I-5, in Shafter outside of Bakersfield. The ITTC is a development of The Allen Group, based in San Diego

industrial park. Next to the podium will be a large sitemap of the park, showing the exact rail line location. There will be opportunities for B-roll coverage before and after the event, as the ceremony site is adjacent to existing buildings, including Target's regional

distribution center.

WHEN: Wednesday, December 14, 2005, 10:30 – 11:30 am PT

WHERE: West end cul-de-sac of Fanucchi Way, north of 7th Standard Road, Shafter, Calif.

ITTC: The International Trade and Transportation Center (ITTC) is a 700-acre master-planned

industrial park located in California's southern San Joaquin Valley on the main line of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway. The ITTC is home to Target Stores' 1.7 million square foot regional distribution center. Thirty-five million consumers are within a four-hour drive of the property, which will feature an intermodal facility allowing direct rail service to and from the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach, for shippers and distributors

serving the western United States.
