
Located in Shafter, in the heart of Kern County, California, and just 3 miles north of Bakersfield city limits, The International Trade and Transportation Center is being built on over 700 acres selected for its proximity to a vast labor pool and its geographic position at the center of California. 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
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Land and Build to Suit Opportunities

Served by the adjacent BNSF main rail line, ITTC offers one of the only rail-served opportunities for new construction within the entire Central Valley region of California.






The ITTC project is located in the geographic population center of the State of California, with the entire Western U.S. region reachable within one day's drive time.

The International Trade & Transportation Center also offers maximum flexibility to utilize the Port of Oakland in addition to the Worldports of LA and Long Beach.














Location Map









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
